Dear Parents/Carers,

On Wednesday 18th January Caradoc and Oak Classes will be taking part in an exciting 'Roman Day' at the Grosvenor Museum in Chester. During the visit, the children will take part in exciting activities such as a Roman Workshop, which will include an introduction as to why the Romans came to Britain and the opportunity to explore Roman artefacts. They will also take part in a Roman Solider Tour, where they will become Roman Soldiers, carrying shields and marching through Chester City Centre. The children will also have the opportunity to explore the museum itself throughout the day, to help consolidate their learning.

As there will be a lot of walking involved on our day, we ask that the children wear comfortable walking shoes, full school uniform and bring with them a raincoat.

We will be leaving school by coach at 9.00am and returning at the end of the school day.

The PTA are very kindly subsidising the cost of this visit, however, to make it possible we have asked for a voluntary contribution of £13.00 per child to be made via School Spider. Please also be aware that due to the costings of the trip we would not be able to refund the cost if your child was absent on the day. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium funding no payment is required.

Please ensure your child brings a packed lunch and any snacks/refreshments in a small rucksack or bag and plenty to drink (not fizzy or glass bottles please). Alternatively, a packed lunch is available to order from school at the cost of £2.50.
