The Schools Calendar Project has been running now for eight years with the cost of printing the Calendars each year generously sponsored by local business in the town. The Calendar Project has been able to raise over £9000 for schools so far. Funds raised from the sale of the Calendars this year, as last year, will be used to provide Art Workshops, run by local artist Malcom Hague, for every class in each of the participating schools throughout the school year.

We are asking parents, governors and friends of each school to help us with raising the funding for the children's Art Workshops by buying a copy of the 2022 calendar for their own use or as a Christmas gift for grandparents or other relations.

The 2022 Market Drayton Schools Calendar will be on sale at £5.00 in all the participating schools and will also be available at venues in the town during the Drayton ArtsFest on 29th - 31st October.
