Dear Parents/Guardians,

As part of our World War II topic, Stiperstones class will be visiting Cosford Air Museum on Monday 3rd October 2022. Whilst at the museum, we will be taking part in a workshop to find out more about the Battle of Britain and the children will have the opportunity to explore all the exhibitions there also. It will be a great day and the children will get lots of first hand opportunities to explore what it was like to have lived through World War II.

The cost of this trip is **£6.00** per child, please make payment through the 'Bookings and Payments' section of School Spider. This cost is to cover some of the transport cost to and from the museum. The rest of the transport cost and the workshop fee will be subsidised by the PTFA. I would like to thank the PTFA for their contribution towards this trip. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium funding (previously known as Free School Meals), no payment is required.

The coach will be leaving school from 9.15am outside the school gate, arriving back at school at 3pm for usual pick up. Children are to come into school in their normal time for registration and will be escorted to the bus by staff.

A packed lunch for your child can be provided at the cost of £2.50 and will consist of a ham, cheese or tuna sandwich, biscuit, piece of fruit, yoghurt and a drink, alternatively, a packed lunch can be brought from home, any snacks/refreshments will need to be in a small rucksack (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please). Please complete the form on School Spider to confirm your child's lunch choice by **Thursday 29th September**.

Children will need to wear school uniform, and bring a water bottle and coat as some of the day will be spent outdoors.
